

Global Indian International School unveils largest display of bread tags in commemoration of Singapore's 48th National Day

Display certified by Singapore Book of Records as the largest of its kind in Singapore

- **Global Indian International School (GIIS), Balestier Campus** unveiled Singapore's largest display of bread tags on Wednesday, August 7, 2013, in commemoration of Singapore's 48th National Day.
- Titled '*Recycled Creation: Art meets French Language*', the display was unveiled by Guest of Honour, **Ms Claire-Lise Dautry**, Executive Director of Alliance Française de Singapour.
- The display – depicting national and cultural symbols of Singapore and France – has been made using approximately **13,000 plastic bread tags**, which were collected by students over a period of four months, and re-used to give shape to the display.
- The display has been created with the objective of instilling appreciation for French language among students, and reflecting Singapore's multilingual and multicultural environment. The display will be used as an educational tool for French lessons in the school.
- Mr Ong Eng Huat, President of Singapore Book of Records, verified the entry of the display as the largest made using bread tags and awarded the school with a certification.
